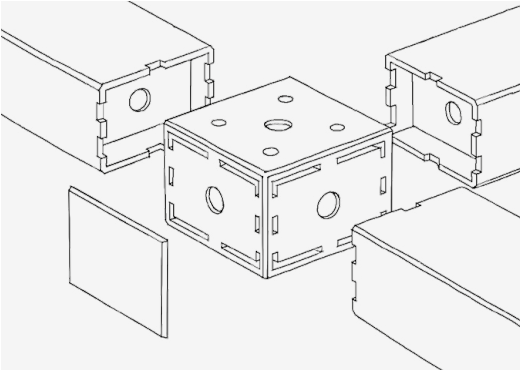
WorkKit is a simple, logical and extremely flexible solution conveying a subtle impression for communicative office areas. With a cube-shaped connecting element named PIN and a few additional parts, WorkKit can be spontaneously reconfigured and adapted to new demands caused by expansion, reduction or remodelling. Adjustable screens can be mounted depending on varying requirements for communication or concentration. Individual workstations can also be equipped with personal storage components including file boxes and an under-table box.



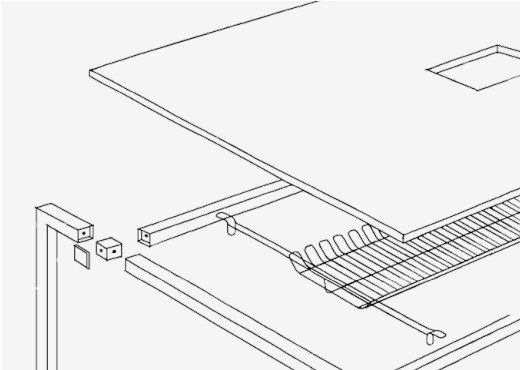
WorkKit screens can be fitted with accessories such as shelves for papers and CDs, vases, magnet boards, business card holders and mirrors.

Flexibility
WorkKit has a modular design that meets individual needs and wishes using standard components. Only a few components are needed to create all kinds of configurations, which can easily be changed to suit new spaces or a change in use or numbers of employees.

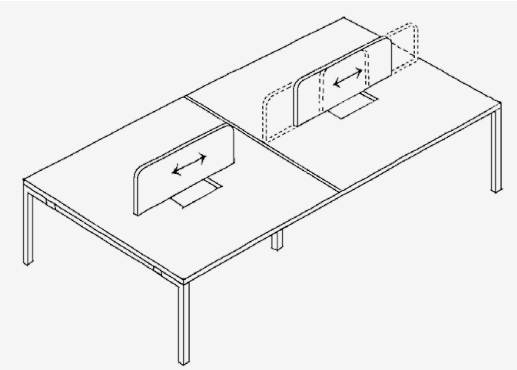
Functionality
WorkKit is simple to put together and offers functional electrification solutions as well as screens and accessories to allow individual workstation designs. Light and flatscreen brackets can be easily integrated by means of an adaptor.



The extremely simple construction principle using the PIN connecting element means that the office system is highly flexible in terms of potential layouts.



Its design gives WorkKit a very high level of stability with a minimum of parts.



The workstation with adjustable screens and a multifunctional electrification solution can be spontaneously reconfigured and adapted.

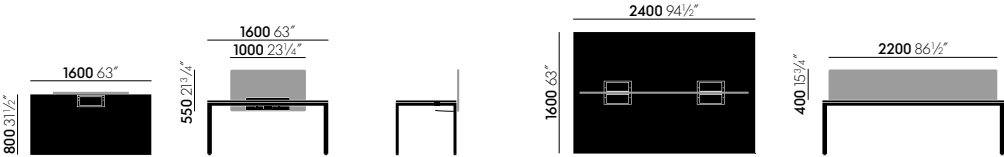
Efficiency

All measurements are in mm and inches, pursuant to EN 1335-1

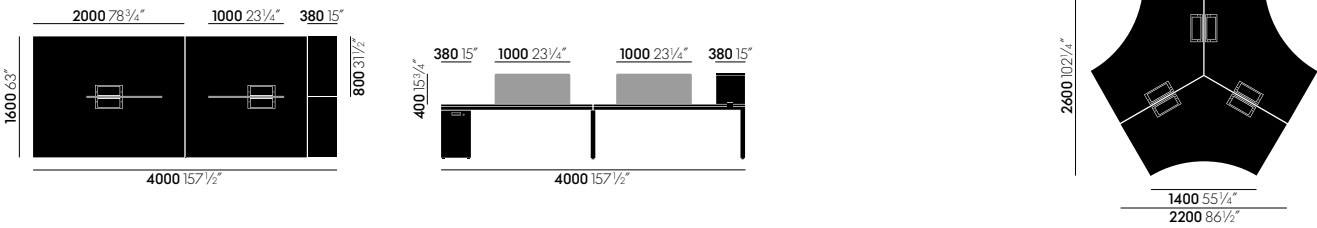
Individual workstation / territorial

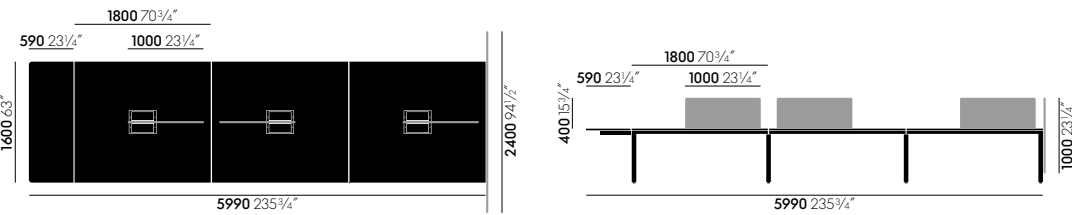


Team of four workstations / territorial The tabletop creating an environment ideal for communicating and thus also for spontaneous and informal meetings.
